

EVALUASI PROGRAM KETAHANAN PANGAN DI DESA GUNUNG JAMBAT KECAMTAN SUAK MIDAI KABUPATEN NATUNA

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ABSTRAK

Program Program Ketahanan Pangan melalui pemberian bibit ayam pedaging di Desa Gunung Jambat dilaksanakan untuk meningkatkan ketersediaan pangan dan kesejahteraan masyarakat melalui pemanfaatan Dana Desa. Realisasi anggaran program pada tahun 2023 mencapai 96%, namun hasil pelaksanaan program belum sesuai dengan tujuan yang diharapkan, dari 2.000 ekor, hanya 1.081 ekor yang berhasil dipanen dengan tingkat keberhasilan hanya sekitar 54,05%. Kesenjangan antara realisasi administratif dan capaian hasil di lapangan sehingga perlu dilakukan evaluasi. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengevaluasi pelaksanaan Program Ketahanan Pangan melalui pemberian bibit ayam pedaging di Desa Gunung Jambat dengan model CIPP (*Context, Input, Process, Product*) yang dikemukakan oleh Stufflebeam & Coryn. Penelitian ini menggunakan metode kualitatif dengan pendekatan deskriptif. Pengumpulan data dilakukan melalui wawancara, observasi, dokumentasi, dan studi Pustaka. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa pada aspek konteks, program telah sesuai dengan kebutuhan masyarakat, didukung kebijakan pemerintah, serta sejalan dengan kondisi lingkungan desa yang memadai. Pada aspek input, anggaran cukup memadai tetapi sarana dan prasarana serta kemampuan teknis pendampingan masih terbatas. Pada aspek proses, penyaluran bantuan kelompok penerima serta telah berjalan sesuai rencana, namun monitoring, pembinaan, dan koordinasi belum dilakukan secara optimal. Pada aspek produk, program belum mencapai tujuan karena tingginya angka kematian ayam, rendahnya hasil panen, serta belum memberikan manfaat ekonomi yang berkelanjutan. Pelaksanaan Program Ketahanan Pangan di Desa Gunung Jambat Tahun 2023 belum optimal dan memerlukan perbaikan pada tahap perencanaan, peningkatan kapasitas sumber daya manusia, pendampingan teknis, analisis pasar, serta pengawasan agar tujuan program dapat tercapai secara efektif.

EVALUATION OF THE FOOD SECURITY PROGRAM IN GUNUNG JAMBAT SUAK MIDAI DISTRICT NATUNA REGENCY

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ABSTRACT

The Food Security Program through the provision of broiler chicks in Gunung Jambat Village was implemented to improve food availability and community welfare through the utilization of Village Funds. The realization of the program budget in 2023 reached 96%, but the results of the program implementation have not been in accordance with the expected objectives, out of 2,000 chickens, only 1,081 chickens were successfully harvested with a success rate of only around 54.05%. The gap between administrative realization and results achieved in the field requires an evaluation. This study aims to evaluate the implementation of the Food Security Program through the provision of broiler chicks in Gunung Jambat Village using the CIPP (Context, Input, Process, Product) model proposed by Stufflebeam & Coryn. This study uses a qualitative method with a descriptive approach. Data collection was carried out through interviews, observations, documentation, and literature studies. The results of the study indicate that in the context aspect, the program has been in accordance with community needs, supported by government policies, and in line with adequate village environmental conditions. In the input aspect, the budget is quite adequate but facilities and infrastructure and technical assistance capabilities are still limited. In terms of process, aid distribution to recipient groups has proceeded according to plan, but monitoring, guidance, and coordination have not been optimal. In terms of product, the program has not achieved its objectives due to high chicken mortality rates, low harvest yields, and the failure to provide sustainable economic benefits. The implementation of the Food Security Program in Gunung Jambat Village in 2023 has not been optimal and requires improvements in the planning stage, human resource capacity building, technical assistance, market analysis, and supervision to ensure the program's objectives are effectively achieved.
