CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the Problem

When writing texts, students face several obstacles in conveying their ideas due to lack of vocabulary. But learning to write can help students think critically and critically to write good writing. Since English is a foreign language in Indonesia, many teaching and learning achievements are needed in schools.
