## CHAPTER I

If pupils grasp vocabulary, they can readily advance their language abilities in the areas of speaking, listening, reading, and writing, claim Cahyono \& Widianti in Ghina (2021). If students can master vocabulary, they can learn English with ease. The teacher, however, must have a plan for how the children can effectively master language.

Reading, listening, speaking, and writing are the four abilities that are covered in teaching English, per the English curriculum. Understanding the aspects of language that relate to grammar is beneficial for the four abilities mentioned above. A person needs a large vocabulary in order to effectively use a second language since without it, they won't be able to fully utilize the structures and functions they are learning for effective communication.
