After classifying all the data gathered from interviews, the summary of interviews regarding teachers' perceptions on the use of Instagram in English teaching at SMAN 2 Tanjungpinang was displayed in table 4.2.1 as follows:

10.	Instagram's use received positive responses, as evidenced by the comments teachers observed.				
11	Instagram-related issues were managed by maintaining flexibility and having backup plans in case the technology did not cooperate, while teachers also conducted technology checks beforehand to ensure they had enough working devices and a reliable connection.				
12	Instagram explored particularly memorable or successful experiences that teachers had had using the platform in their English teaching.				
13	Teachers used Instagram, suggesting that it could be an effective tool for engaging students in learning English.

## 4.2.2 Questionnaire
