### **INTRODUCTION**

### 1.1 Background of The Study

English language divided into four skills: listening, reading, writing, and speaking. Listening practice is a foundation that students must understand, and becoming a fundamental skill in learning English. As human beings who always communicate, we always want to understand. This is a strategy that will improve our English listening abilities, inspire others, and advance their language comprehension.

Based on the syllabus of SMKN 1 Bintan Timur, students are expected to be able to identify pronunciation, words, intonation, analyze the social function and linguistic elements of song lyrics that contain inspiration, and capture the meaning of the song. At the same time, in activities Like taking in English-language films, news stories, and music can be stimulating. Based on pre-observation, there are many problems in using listening skills, many students are easily distracted if the teacher talks too much and feel they do not understand the material given. Based on these problems, the researcher suggests using audio-visual media in learning to make it more interesting and not tend to be monotonous. This research aims to help students learn to be more interesting and not become monotonous, especially in listening skills. The researcher chose Disney songs as learning media to stimulate students' enthusiasm for learning and be more careful in listening

According to Adawiyah (2017), Using familiar elements with students in the classroom increases their interest and focus on learning. Young students are expected to enjoy listening to music worldwide. Some students enjoy listening to songs while watching music videos, for example, Disney songs. The words and expressions used in the songs are very useful with basic structures used in daily routines. Researchers, with the context of this study, attempt to utilize learning media to enhance students' listening abilities. One effective tool for language classrooms is Disney songs. The researcher believes that Disney songs will enable students to practice English more actively, foster independent learning, and boost their motivation and desire to learn English. However, research is still needed to investigate whether Disney songs can be used as

English learning media at the secondary school level. Therefore, this research was conducted to provide it.

Based on interview with Mam Febrianti as English teacher grade 11 RPL SMKN 1 Bintan Timur, which is directly involved with students, researcher find many issues with students in the classroom regarding the most challenging aspect of listening skills, namely:

- 1. The students cannot communicate effectively in English because it's an extremely challenging language to learn, particularly for listening comprehension.
- 2. The students lack students drive and enthusiasm for studying English as a foreign language because they are more concentrated on software (RPL) and are not interested in.
- 3. The student's attention is easily distracted when the teacher is explaining.
- 4. The students have difficulties understanding what they hear.
