

# CHAPTER I

## INTRODUCTION

### 1.1 Background of The Study

Pronunciation is one of the keys to speaking any foreign language, especially English. This is because mispronunciation can affect the understanding of the language itself. According to Hayati (in Hartini, 2020) one of the difficult skills for language users is English pronunciation and it is very important for language learners. Additionally, pronunciation is a crucial skill for L2 learners to acquire as, if a word is mispronounced in a communication, it will result in a complete communication breakdown.

Many misunderstandings regarding the words' meaning occur due to incorrect and improper pronunciation. Gilakjani (2011), stated that an intelligible speaker will leave the audience unable to understand what they are saying.

As a student of the English education study program at UMRAH, the researcher found that many students often mispronounced some of the words during their daily conversation, which led to misunderstandings in speaking. Based on the explanation above and combined with the researchers' experience as a student at UMRAH, the researcher found that many students still lack good pronunciation, affecting their speaking skills.
